Entry Requirements

- Minimum age of 18 years
- Completion of Year 12 and or equivalent
- English proficiency levels of IELTS 5.5 or equivalent or completion of a Literacy, Language and Numeracy (LLN) assessment at ACSF Level 4
- Mature Age students will also be considered without the minimum education requirements providing they have relevant work experience within the chosen area of study and a demonstrated capacity to meet the course requirements.

Duration

This course will be delivered over 52 weeks including 8 weeks term break over the duration of the course.
